This is an interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Privacy Office, dated May 5, 2022.

For this production, DHS processed 352 pages of documentation of which 14 pages are withheld in full, seven pages are released in full, and 271 pages are withheld in part pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(5) and (b)(6). Four pages were non-responsive, and 46 pages were sent to another agency for consultation. The 306 pages for release are Bates stamped DHS-001-002015-000001 through DHS-001-02015-000292.
